AutoCAD History AutoCAD, like all major CAD systems today, was developed in the mid-1980s, by Digital Equipment Corporation (DEC) programmers who wanted a CAD system that had the efficiency, ease-of-use, and affordability of the popular VisiCalc spreadsheet program, plus a user interface as close as possible to the IBM mainframe COBOL and PL/I programming languages. These programmers – William F. Swanson, Frank Tschanz, Steve Sommerville, Steve Saggello, and Daryl King, together with a handful of other engineers – had previously worked for DEC on the popular and powerful VAX computer. They took their ideas to their new company, Microsoft, and received permission to develop a new program, known as "Autodesk," that would run on the popular and affordable VMS operating system. The project was approved and started in 1982, and the first version of AutoCAD was released in December 1982. That year DEC also released a 32-bit VAX computer for CAD, which it called the MacroStation. In the early 1980s, the market for desktop CAD was small, but by the end of the decade the market had grown to such a size that DEC felt they had a viable business. This situation encouraged the company to continue the development of the software; and in 1990, DEC was acquired by Novell, Inc. Novell continued the development of AutoCAD under the name Autodesk. Prior to the 1980s, the need for CAD software had mostly been driven by two factors: the increasing need for engineering drawings, and the increasing use of computer-aided design and manufacturing for the production of physical goods. The early AutoCAD drawings were simple designs, with basic geometric shapes, and could not handle the types of engineering drawings or complex design work that is typical today. These early drawings were pretty much the same as the Drawings Software (DRAW) system produced by Intergraph Corporation, which was a widely used commercial program in the mid-1970s. DRAW ran on minicomputers and was used by engineers at many companies throughout the 1970s and early 1980s. But unlike the popular VAX-based CAD software then available, DRAW was designed for a high-end minicomputer, and it lacked certain features common to today's CAD systems, including annotation, editing, and data interchange.
